Seasons for Growth is a group for children who are transitioning through change.


The Level 2 Seasons for Growth group is continuing this term


## **BUZ (Build Up Zone)**

## Unat's Been Happening in Room 7











This term, Room 7 has been exploring the connection between multiplication and division. Students have enjoyed using hands-on materials such as counters, MAB blocks, and playdough to build groups, share collections, and create arrays. These practical activities have made learning fun and engaging, while also helping students clearly see how numbers can be put together and taken apart in different ways. We have also focused on explaining our thinking to others, building confidence in using multiplication and division strategies. Students are beginning to recognise how these skills connect to real-life situations, such as sharing food, grouping objects, and solving everyday problems.

## ATTENDANCE SMS

Thornlie Primary School is transitioning to a new system, this means all Attendance SMS messages will now come from a new contact Thornlie PS.

The new system will notify parents, guardians and caregivers of unexplained absences or late arrivals.

## What will change for Parents?

The new system will send parents an SMS on their mobile phone when their child is marked absent without an explanation.

Parents should delete the old Absentee SMS number to avoid confusion. They should not use it to communicate with the school.

Parents will get the SMS with the link if their child is marked absent without an explanation. Parents should use this link to add attendance notes about their child's absence. Please note that the link will be valid for only 48 hours. Do not reply to this message via SMS as the school will not receive it. The school will receive your response vial the link provided. Ensure the phone is connected to an Internet data plan or has WIFI access to use the hyperlink.

If your child is absent again without a prior explanation, parents will get a new one-time link.

If parents do not use the link provided, they can notify the school of their child's absence via telephone 9232 3450 or email thornlie.ps@education.wa.edu.au

For absences that are planned in advance you must complete a "Extended Absence from School" form available from the front office.

When students leave school for an appointment or any other reason they must be signed out at the front office. Should they return that same day they must be signed back in.

Please ensure your day time contact number, mobile number and email address are up to date.




