

The jump and throw events will be held on Wednesday October 22nd and the carnival on **Friday October 24**th.


SCHOOL BOARD - Parents Needed !!




This strength-based program utilises games, activities and stories, engaging students as they learn about themselves and their peers.

You may notice that BUZ has a new look but it still has the same core values.


BUZ classes are finished for the year while Mrs Thomas is away on Long Service Leave, but we can still practice being a BUZ school!


